The 36,000-square-foot Autumn Leaves of Windward – design winner of the prestigious 2016 Argentum Senior Living Design Award – offers many amenities. The building's seamless figure 8 design provides a safe, homelike environment for residents to wander freely, while enjoying self-contained outdoor courtyards, gardening areas, walking paths, and a putting green. Residents' rooms are equipped with a specialized nurse-call system that adds an extra measure of safety in caring for people with dementia. Care and activity plans are individualized to the resident's interests, preferences, needs, and wants to promote calm, comfort, and cognition.

Autumn Leaves of Windward also features a "relaxation room."
